UNCOMFORTABLE

HOW DO YOU KNOW IF YOU'RE TOO COMFORTABLE?

How Do You Know If You Are Too Comfortable? Let's face it - even with the challenges in our society to Christianity and the church, we are able to remain pretty comfortable. We don't worry that the Davidson County Sheriff's Office is going to kick in the door or even threaten to stop our worship. We are able to live a pretty comfortable life, but is that a good thing?

C. S. Lewis once said, "I didn't go to religion to make me happy. I always knew a bottle of Port would do that. If you want a religion to make you feel really comfortable, I certainly don't recommend Christianity." What are some signs that our Christianity has become too cozy, more like a pleasant bottle of port than the uncomfortable, risky faith the New Testament presents? I came across several marks of comfort that we all need to be uncomfortable with.

1. Your friends and coworkers are surprised to learn you're a churchgoing Christian.

A sure sign your faith is too comfortable is if nothing in your life sets you apart as a Jesus follower, to the point that even those who know you well can't tell you're a Christian. *A comfortable Christian is one who easily blends in, looking and talking and acting just like his or her lost neighbors.*

2. You never think about or even remember the Sunday sermon on Monday.

If Sunday sermons at your church are so forgettable (or you're so disengaged) that you rarely recall them after you leave church, your Christianity is probably too comfortable.

Biblical preaching shouldn't leave us apathetic or unchallenged.

The Word of God is "living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart" Hebrews 4:12

3. You never feel challenged, only affirmed.

If your Christian faith never confronts your idols and challenges your sinful habits—but only ever affirms you as you are—this is a sure sign of a too-comfortable faith. *Healthy faith doesn't just celebrate you as you are but relentlessly molds and refines you into the likeness of Christ, which is a beautiful but necessarily uncomfortable process.*

4. You've never had to have a 'truth-in-love' conversation with a fellow Christian.

It's always more comfortable to just “live and let live” when there's an offense or sin that needs to be called out. It's more comfortable to just shrug when we see others in our community making unhealthy decisions. But this isn't true Christian love. *Love isn't opposed to truth, and if your faith doesn't include the capacity to speak hard truths in love, it's too comfortable.*

5. No one in your church could comment on any area of growth they've seen in you.

To believe in the gospel of Jesus Christ is to believe in change. The Christian life should be marked by growth, forward momentum, and change for the better. If you're a Christian who's grown so little that no one in your church could identify any area of improvement, your faith is too comfortable. *So... are you ready to be uncomfortable. You see, to be a community of Jesus followers is to trade a comfortable, me-centric, existence for danger and discomforts of all sorts. But it's the best trade you will ever make.*

Starting February 7th we will enter our discomfort zones with the series “Uncomfortable”. We will be reminded that when the Christian church is comfortable & cultural it tends to be weak. When it is uncomfortable and countercultural it is strong. May we all learn that we grow most when outside our comfort zones... where true peace is found.

Daily Cues



Morning Time

Sometimes, without knowing it we just expect teens to forget or fail. But, what if you expected to be surprised, impressed, and proud—and then told them? This week be sure to give them encouragement. Try saying, “Hey, this past year has, in general, have been pretty crazy. You’ve handled it like a champ. I’m so proud of you and love watching you become the person you were made to be. Keep it up.”



Their Time

Teens can often feel like adults don’t really get them. So, practicing being a student of them. Ask questions. Use not knowing and not being afraid to be asking as a way to connect and make them feel like an expert. Let them know you don’t take yourself too seriously. Expressing curiosity around the way their friends think and talk, instead of judgment or disgust, will earn their trust.



Meal Time

Make some time for you and your teen to grab a meal or coffee or smoothie out on you. Take time to ask questions about their friends, their school experience, pressures they might experience, or just to hear them rant about the latest drama. Remember, you aren’t there to fix their problem, downplay, or correct their thinking. You’re there to listen, sympathize, and make them feel understood.



Bed Time

Sometimes, teens need a conversation they want to have, but they aren’t always sure how. Before your teen heads to bed, reassure your teen that you’ll always be there for them and that your love for them won’t change or your relationship compromised—no matter what. Nothing they tell you could change that. Be sure that this message, is clear in your words, tone, and body language.

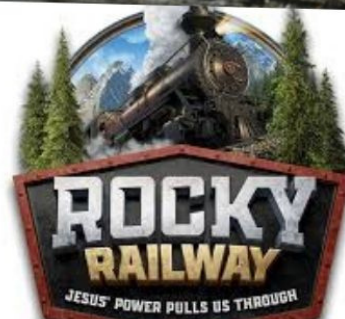

Outreach Committee ...

We wanted to share information about the Mt. Pleasant Outreach Fund. The money donated to the Outreach Fund is used to assist individuals or families who have a financial emergency or face bills due to an unexpected event in their lives that causes financial challenges – such as a medical event, death in the family, loss of home, loss of income and more. If we know of someone who needs our help we may designate that person or family as the recipient of the money collected over the course of a particular month. In addition to the person designated to receive the monthly gifts, we receive calls from individuals who need help with a power bill, water bill, rent, groceries and more. Often these people only need a small amount of money and we can help them get past the current emergency. When we don't have a person designated for any particular month all the money collected goes in the Outreach Account; which allows us to take care of the smaller needs that arise. Whether the need is large or small, the help received can make a real difference to the person or family receiving the help. It can mean having something to eat, heat in their home or money for whatever the need is; or being hungry or cold. We appreciate all donation made to Outreach and the money will be used to make a difference in lives, as the recipients are sometimes so surprised that someone they didn't even know cared about them so much. This is one way we can be the hands and feet of Christ. The recipients can, but don't have to attend Mt. Pleasant. 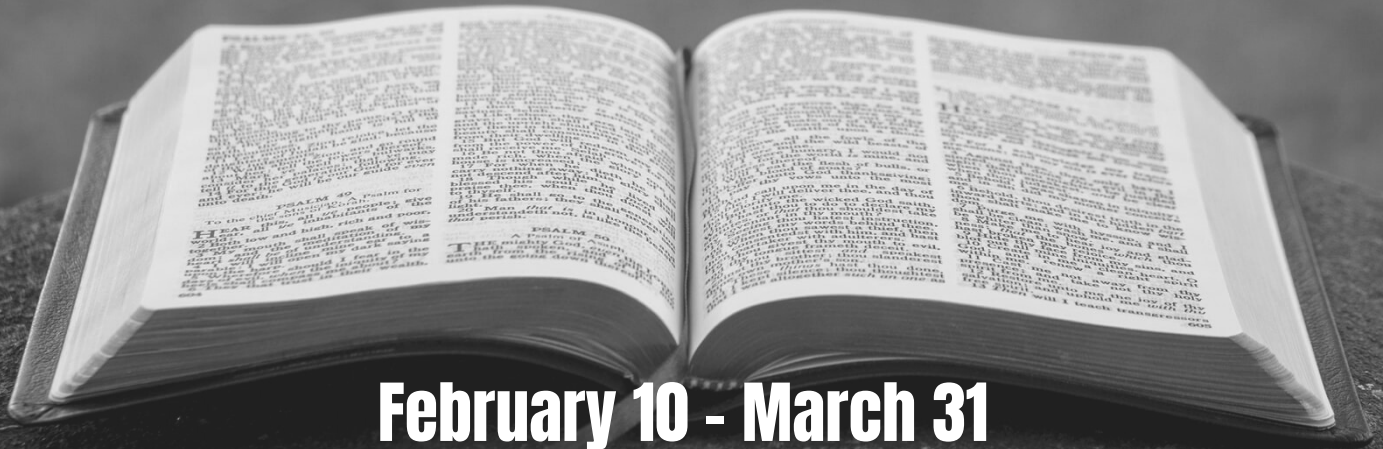

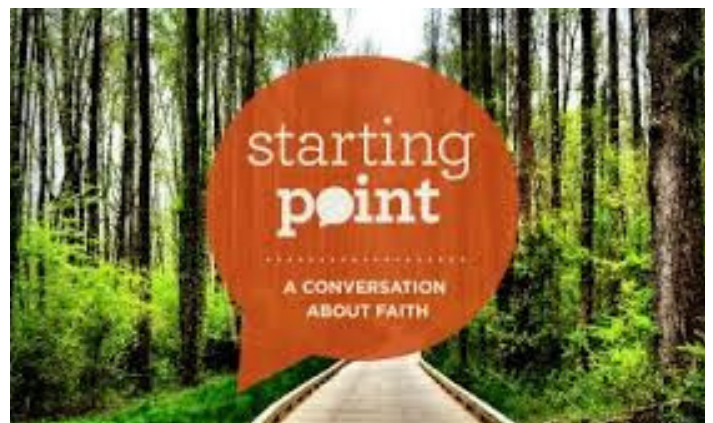
