That is, until we realize followers of Christ don't get to decide what is most important. It does not change with the season of life we find ourselves in. It is not some mystery we are left to solve.

Jesus Himself gave us the top priority: "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matt. 6:33). He said, in effect, "This is your priority; this comes first."

If I am to seek first in my life God's kingdom and God's righteousness, then whatever else I do ought to relate to that goal: where I work, with whom I spend my time, the one I marry, or the decision to remain single. Every decision I make ought to be filtered through the Matthew 6:33 filter: where I put my money, where and how I spend my time, what I give away.

Living out the kingdom life means that everything must remain before the throne and under the authority of the ruler. Everything must be held loosely.

Life places before us hundreds of possibilities. Some are bad. Many are good.But only one is the best. But each of us must decide, "What priority takes first place in my life?"

Over the past month the Elders have been working on the Deacon role at Mt. Pleasant. Since this is a new role at the church we have spent quite a bit of time discussing what the needs are and how to best organize our ministries under the leadership of Deacons. Once we categorized the different roles, we considered who in our body would be the best candidates to take on the challenges.

One of these challenges is that we have never had the role before. This was indeed a blank slate for us to work out the goals of our church. We have put together some job descriptions to help explain what each Deacon would be working on and who their teams would be. Our plan is to finalize the recommendations with the Administrative Council and formally announce the Deacon ministry in the next month. Below is a list of the different roles we identified and a short description of that Deacon's role:

Family Ministries: Works to minister to not only youth and children but the whole family. Helps get new families connected at MTP.

Youth Ministries: Works alongside Donnie B. to support him and meet the needs of our Youth program.

Children Ministries: Works alongside Jennifer to support her and meet the needs of the Children's program.

Adult Ministries: Coordinates the adult ministries at the church and helps integrate all the adult ministries. Also works to get new members connected at MTP.

Pastoral Care: Works alongside our Associate Pastor for Pastoral Care to reach out to those in our body who need physical, emotional and spiritual comfort during difficult times.

Outreach/Missions: Coordinates our outreach and mission activities.

Administration: Works with the Finance team and Trustees to make sure MTP is prepared to support our ministries.

The other item we have been working on is replacing Donnie Durham as our Pastoral Care Associate.We believe that this will likely be a full-time position and will advertise for an Associate Pastor for Pastoral Care and Counseling that works full time to support those needs in our body.If you know of a person who may be interested, please contact one of the Elders or Pastor Chris.



Daily Cues



Morning Time

The morning can be a stressful time for your student. They're worried about what they look like, being on time, or just stressing out about whatever is going in the day ahead. As they're getting ready, try dropping by just to tell them that you believe in and ask if you can help them with getting ready.



Meal Time

Surprise your student with their favorite meal! This seems like a small gesture but can truly change their mood as they cope with stress. Go all out and theme out the whole meal. If they love alfredo make it an Italian themed or if they love hot dogs, make it sports themed. Make this meal something special, a meal they will never forget.



Their Time

The next time your teen brings up being stressed—try to listen first. This can make a big difference for your teen—to be heard and not just getting your quick response—show first that you care. List their whole situation first and then ask: "How can I help?". Let them tell you what advice or direction they want to hear and be willing to only take it as far as they are willing to go.



Bed Time

Before the end of the night, ask your teen what the best and worst parts of their day were. This is all about listening and being curious. You can also find out why they were the best and worst parts of the day. The goal is to get to know what makes their day great and what stresses them out. If you have time, let them know about your day too as a way to mutually connect on a deeper level.
