

THE BIG ASK

Matthew 16:13-20, Acts 1:1-11

Why do people visit a church for the first time? Below are some stats to think about.

2% by Advertisement6% by the Pastoral Invitation6% by organized evangelism campaign86% by friends or relatives

Drum roll.....Only 2% of church people invite an unchurched person to church each year.

I think these statistics tell us why churches are not either growing or exploding... people don't love the unchurched enough to invite them.

Because Jesus promised to build His Church and has given us the Holy Spirit to empower us, we can have confidence and boldness when inviting people to church!

Most people would not attend a party they aren't invited to. This applies to church too. While we know that the doors are always open and everyone is invited, most of the time people won't feel comfortable coming unless someone has invited them. This is where we play our part. People hear the gospel and encounter Jesus at church, and because of this, evangelism starts with me inviting them!

We interact with hundreds of different people every week. The person who serves you at a restaurant, your teachers, your classmates, and your family all need Jesus. Inviting the person bringing your salad to your table can be an uncomfortable moment for all involved, but when we invite people to church we are giving them an opportunity to hear and respond to the message of Jesus because church is a place where Jesus is celebrated and the gospel is preached. You don't need a masters in theology, you simply need to be bold enough to let them know they are invited!


- Write down three names of people you will invite to church the next time you see them.
 - Take a few minutes right now and ask Jesus to give you the boldness to invite these people to church. Also ask Him to soften their hearts so that when they hear the message of Jesus they would be saved.

Imagine, whose salvation is on the other side of an invitation from you? You might be afraid of them turning you down, but that's OK. You have nothing to lose and they have everything to gain – it's worth the ask!

Feeding the Hungry

Help the Mission Committee feed the Homeless

We will be providing a meal each month at Cooperative Community Ministry (CCM) in Thomasville.

The Mission Committee has committed to feed homeless folks at the Cooperative Community Ministry (CCM) once a month (with the exception of April and December) on the 2nd Thursday of each month.

Currently, they are feeding 80 people beginning at 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Meals are handed out at the back door.

There is a small kitchen with a refrigerator, 2 stoves, a microwave and a couple of warmers that do work. Paper products (trays, bags) and packets of mayo, mustard, ketchup are available.

Suggestions for meals are manwiches, grilled chicken sandwiches, hot dogs, and pizza. These are only suggestions, but they like simple food items. Along with any of these, you could provide Little Debbies, fruit, cookies, etc.

More directions will be provided to those who volunteer to help us meet our commitment.
