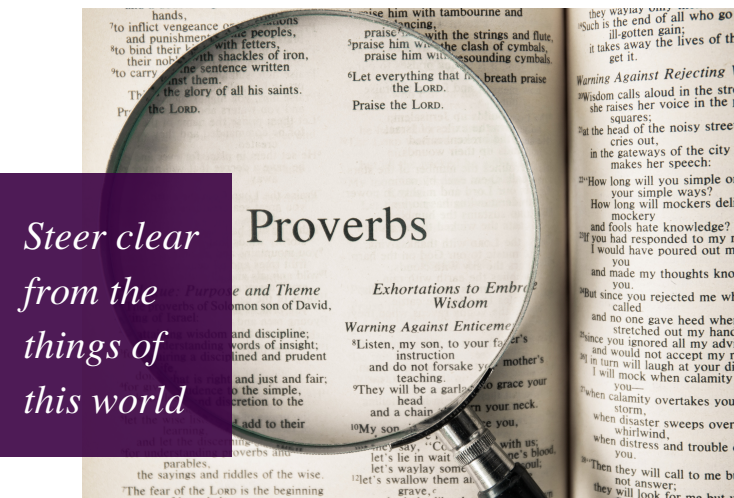

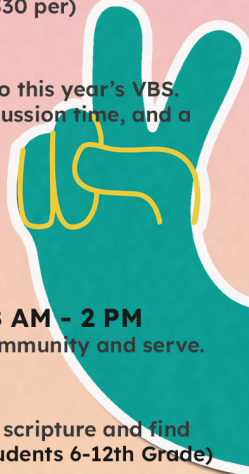
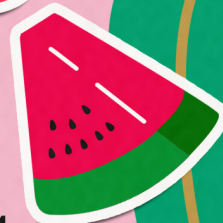

And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts ..." (Acts 2:42-46)

Neil and Lindsey Broere are familiar names to longtime members of the Mt. Pleasant Church family. The two grew up in Davidson County, Neil in the Wallburg area and Lindsey in Thomasville, and Neil has preached at Mt. Pleasant as recently as 2021.

Mt. Pleasant Church supported the Broeres prayerfully and financially when they answered a missionary call to see the Middle Eastern Church reestablished. They not only founded the non-profit Iron Kite International ministry, but, along with their four children, also made their home in Iraq for five years. They desired mightily to "demonstrate the love of God to all who would seek Him."

However, danger intensified in Iraq, and in 2021 God gave them a new vision: To build a house for the Lord in America. They returned to the United States in November 2021 and searched for where God wanted to plant them. That search led them to relocate to California in April 2022.

There, friends introduced them to former missionaries Roger and Roxanne Sachs. Roger Sachs is the founder and president of Freedom Crusade which is involved in missions, church planting and media. He and his wife also established Pearl Chapel by the Sea at Shell Beach, California, in 2015, but in early 2022 Roger's health was such that the couple took a three-month sabbatical from a leadership role. After the associate pastors left to plant new churches of their own, the Sachses questioned whether this was the end of their dream of a house where the Lord would dwell.

The two couples connected, and the Sachses invited the Broeres to take the lead pastor position at Pearl Chapel.

After much prayer, the Broeres saw the Pearl Chapel as God's answer of Lindsey's vision of expanding a house already built, they said in the July 2022 newsletter to supporters. They took on the lead pastoral role in June 2022.

"He is bringing us to America to demonstrate church as family and community who give themselves to a life marked by daily fellowship, the table, prayer and fasting, and living in community together in the spirit of Acts 2:42-46 ...," the Broeres wrote in the newsletter.

Their vision also meshes with that of Roger and Roxanne Sachs of a church family community.

Pearl Chapel's outreach began with "The Table" gatherings on Thursday nights, in which people gather for a potluck meal, communion, prayer and worship. It has grown from a few people to more than 100 participating. The chapel began holding Sunday morning services in November.

The Broeres and the chapel have raised money to purchase a shuttle bus and renovate it into a "Mobile House of Prayer" as an outreach vehicle. They also want to develop house-church gatherings to keep fellowship intimate to better align with their vision of a church family reflecting God's love.

The Broeres rely on donations to support their family because Pearl Chapel's resources are being used to nurture its growth. They appreciate Mt. Pleasant's continued support.

In an email to Missions Committee chairwoman Tina Grubbs, Neil wrote, "Lindsey and I wanted to thank you and the MTP Missions Committee for the very generous gift that you sent. Thank you so much! It not only blessed us financially, but it encouraged us so much. It was a big leap of faith coming from Iraq to California and we knew our financial support would take a hit. So to have you guys standing with us in such a sacrificial way was very encouraging. Please give our love and gratitude to Pastor Chris and everyone involved in the decision, and please let them know we are thanking God for them out here in California."

MISSION COMMITTEE

July 13 remains available as a volunteer opportunity to participate in "Meals of Grace" at the Cooperative Community Ministry in Thomasville as part of the Mission Committee's yearlong outreach effort at the center. Aug. 10 also is open.

Volunteers prepare and serve take-out meals, distributed from the CCM facility in Thomasville. Currently, we have been asked to prepare around 80 meals to hand out from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Meals can be prepared at the Mt. Pleasant kitchen and taken to the CCM facility or made at the facility's small kitchen which has a refrigerator, 2 stoves, a microwave and a couple of warmers. Paper products (trays, bags) and packets of mayo, mustard and ketchup are available there.

Suggestions for meals are "manwiches," grilled chicken sandwiches, hot dogs and pizza. These are only suggestions, but the CCM managers prefer simple food items. The meal also can include individually wrapped snack cakes, fruit, cookies, chips, etc. More directions will be provided to those who volunteer. Mt. Pleasant is scheduled to serve on the second Thursday of every month (except and December). Please contact Brenda Flack or Tina Grubbs for additional information and to sign up. There also is a sign-up chart in the church lobby.

Many thanks to those who already have served, including Jeff and Shelby Smith and friends; and the Kerygma, Lift and 29:11 small groups. The Friendship group is scheduled for September.

SHOE DRIVE

The Mission Committee also is collecting shoes to distribute to area schools this fall (elementary through high school) in collaboration with Hillside Park Baptist Church's Walking With Jesus outreach. The Thomasville church is asking for new shoes; a collection bin will be in the lobby.
