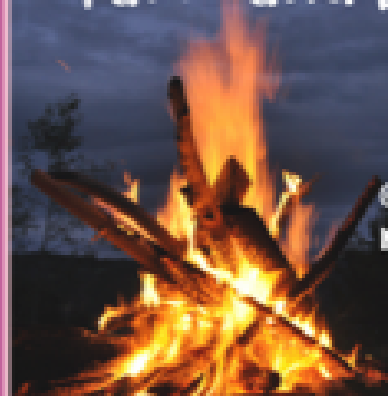

# MISSION COMMITTEE

## **Food Packing Event**

The Mission Committee is gearing up for the annual Each One, Feed One food packing event on Oct. 1.

Once again, the church will partner with River Landing at Sandy Ridge to pack food boxes designed to feed 10,000 people and which will be distributed through seven local organizations.

The committee needs volunteers to pack the boxes and financial donations to help cover the cost of the nutrient dense meals. The cost is anticipated at being between \$3,000 and \$5,000. A collection jug is the church lobby; checks can be made to MTP ("Missions food packing event"). A little will go far: for example, 35 cents will buy a pack of macaroni and cheese for a family of six.

River Landing is a retirement community in Colfax. In the past, a bus has shuttled volunteers to the center.

## **Shoe Collection**

The Mission Committee members appreciate all who donated new shoes for the "Walking With Jesus" initiative. Church members donated 44 pairs of shoes which will be distributed to Thomasville schoolchildren.

## **Progress, Praise, Persecution**

Our brother in Christ, missionary Abraham Thomas, reports great progress has been made in furthering God's Kingdom in India with recent graduates from Logos College of Theology in Kerala, India, carrying the gospel to North India. He also praises God for resolving the delay in Mt. Pleasant's donation reaching Agape Royal Ministries and thanks us for our partnership with him and Agape.

However, persecution of Christians has increased. "Unprecedented spiritual warfare is under way in India both from authorities and enemies of the Gospel," he writes. "Our only refuge is Christ who promised 'the gates of Hades will not prevail against the church.' "

Please join committee members to pray for:

- The ministry in India, Nepal, Myanmar, and Sri Lanka. Especially pray for the ministry in India because of numerous challenges.
- For the state of Manipur where Christians are persecuted.
- For Logos College of Theology Extension – Kenya. Classes are scheduled in the month of September to train pastors and lay people.



It isn't too early to start planning to pack a shoebox or two – or more. The Mission Committee is challenging Mt. Pleasant to prepare 500 shoeboxes as part of Operation Christmas Child.

School supplies are still on sale, and this is a great family activity. Pack boxes for children of the same age and gender as your children or grandchildren.

Grandparents – get in on the action by taking your grandchildren shoebox shopping and then helping them pack their box. A packing party also makes for a great small group activity. Have members of your group sign up to bring specific items. Then get together to pack your boxes. And don't forget to include a photo of your family or group and a note!

Preprinted boxes are available in the lobby. Or use those leftover boxes from your shoe purchases. Or purchase plastic shoe boxes at Walmart or the preprinted plastic boxes at Hobby Hobby.

In addition to school supplies, include personal care items, craft activities, toys, and clothing and accessories.
