

Why We go What We go

Titus 2:11-15 For the grace of God has been revealed, bringing salvation to all people. 12 And we are instructed to turn from godless living and sinful pleasures. We should live in this evil world with wisdom, righteousness, and devotion to God, 13 while we look forward with hope to that wonderful day when the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, will be revealed. 14 He gave his life to free us from every kind of sin, to cleanse us, and to make us his very own people, totally committed to doing good deeds.15 You must teach these things and encourage the believers to do them. You have the authority to correct them when necessary, so don't let anyone disregard what you say.

I bet you have seen the scene play out in a movie or book. One character saves the other from a potential tragedy, and the saved spends the rest of the story serving the savior. Sometimes this plays out in a funny light as the one who did the saving is overwhelmed by the overflow of gratitude. But one thing is sure: The deeds done are not for show, or because it's the right thing to do, but flow from true awe and thankfulness.

When it comes to your relationship with God, what is the motivation behind your behavior? The Bible clearly calls followers of Jesus to serve people, bear one another's burdens, and keep ourselves from sin. What motivates you to do these things? Do you do the right thing because it's what you're supposed to do? Do you do the right thing because people are looking? Or, do you operate like the character in the movie who serves his savior out of thankfulness?

Titus 2:11-15 speaks to grace being our motivation for living a righteous life. "For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live selfcontrolled, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope... eager to do what is good."

Grace is getting what we don't deserve. It is forgiveness, freely given and poured on us (1 Corinthians 2:12). It asks nothing and is not earned (Ephesians 2:9). When we understand salvation is nothing we can do for ourselves and definitely nothing we deserve, it brings us to a place of true thankfulness for what Jesus did. In this realization, we want to live godly lives pleasing to the one who saved us from death. Just like the character in the movie, we want to spend our lives serving our savior.

Something to think about:

- Have you experienced the grace of God, so that you can serve Him out of thankfulness?
- Do you do good deeds out of a sense of duty or as an overflow of love for Jesus?
- What is one practical way to daily remind yourself what Jesus has done for you?

NO PROBLEM: A 4-WEEK STUDY FROM THE OLD & NEW TESTAMENT ON LOVING OTHERS

SERIES OVERVIEW:

Apologies — they're hard to give, but they're sometimes hard to receive, too. When you're the one who has hurt someone else, saying you're sorry (and actually meaning it) takes work and practice. But when you're the one who's been hurt by someone else, things get even more complicated. What if you don't want to forgive them? What if they don't seem sorry? What if they won't even admit they're wrong? What if they've moved on, but you're still not over it? In this 4-week series from the Gospels, we'll find out what it means to truly give (and receive) forgiveness. We'll discover that when you need forgiveness, it's not enough to just apologize. And when you've been hurt and need to forgive, we'll explore the importance of shifting your perspective, remembering God forgave first, and remembering Jesus knows what it's like to be hurt.



ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your teen starts their day, ask, "Is there something you would like me to pray about for you this week? Something that is concerning you or something big coming up?"



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone answer this question: "What is something God has changed in your life or the better?"



Their Time

No matter what your teen shares with you, reserve your strong reactions. If possible, give yourself time to process, and discuss your concerns with them, at another time.



Bed Time

Pray that both you and your teen will be challenged by God's Word to pursue more of the "full life" Jesus offers and not be held back by shame.




MTP Women's Group
