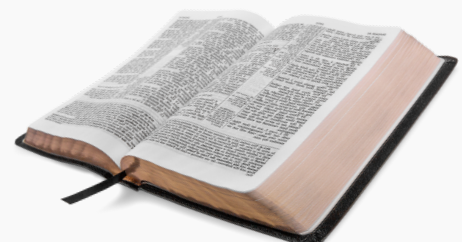

# Mission Committee

---

The Mission Committee closed 2023 by sending an end-of-the-year gift to Abraham Thomas and Agape Royal Ministries.

The \$550 check is sealed with prayers, prayers for the missionaries' safety and prayers they will see continued success in fulfilling the Great Commission: "Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28: 19-20).

Despite increased persecution in 2023, Agape Royal Ministries expanded its church planting initiatives in Nepal with 20 churches and in Sri Lanka with eight churches. Moreover, Logos College Extension began in Kenya with a program to equip church planters by providing a certificate course in two years.

For more than 40 years missionary Abraham Thomas has focused on fulfilling Jesus' command to take the Gospel to the world. Mt. Pleasant Church has supported his efforts with prayers and financial gifts for more than 15 years.

"What a great God we serve!" Rev. Thomas said in a December email to Tina Grubbs, outgoing chairwoman of Mt. Pleasant's Mission Committee. "2023 brought severe challenges that are inexplicable, but they deepened our faith and strengthened our prayer life. No one can thwart God's plans."

He appreciates seeing God at work — "To God be the glory!" — and his ministry's relationship with Mt. Pleasant.

"THANK YOU, very much for your partnership in ministry," he said.

Rev. Thomas is the director of Agape Royal Ministries, with a field office in India. The ministry operates in partnership with Global Compassion, based in Valparaiso, Indiana. Rev. Thomas founded the Agape organization in 1993 in part because he recognized more needed to be done to nurture newly saved believers to grow into knowledgeable disciples.

Agape's objective is "to reach the unreached through preaching the gospel, planting churches, and engaging in compassion ministries," Rev. Thomas said last spring.

He asks Mt. Pleasant Church to join him in prayer for:

- Upcoming events: Logos Extension classes in February; Logos College of Theology Mission Conference and graduation in March, Sri Lanka visit in March, Logos Summer Ministry March – April and youth camps and vacation Bible schools in April;
- Church plants in North India which face severe persecution;
- Major outreach ministries all over India in summer.

Finally, the Mission Committee is thankful for all who helped with its outreach projects in 2023. The successful year was possible only because of the church's support.

## ADULT BIBLE STUDIES

- **Introduction to the Gospels - led by Eric Hilton**

Have you ever wondered why there are 4 gospels? Why only four, why are they different and how are they the same? This study will be an overview of what the similarities and differences of the gospels can tell us. Each writer had a purpose and a message. There will be some history of how the gospels came to be. We will look at recorded events that are found in all four gospels and accounts that are only in one or two of the books. The goal is to give you a basis to navigate your own study with more confidence in navigating the life of Jesus as told by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

- **BodyBuilding - led by Terrie Blevins**

*Let's get in shape for the new year. No workout clothes or equipment needed. During Family Night, we will offer all three courses of the Body Building Series.*

**Body Building 101** (January 10 & 17) *The Shape of Mt Pleasant is a two week course that explains our Bible foundations and organizational structure.*

**Body Building 201** (January 24 - 31) *Getting and Staying in Shape is also a two week course which covers the basic spiritual disciplines of Worship, Bible Study Fellowship, Prayer, Witnessing, and Giving.*

**Body Building 301** (February 7 - 28) *SHAPE'd to Serve is a four week course that looks at how we are all uniquely shaped by God to do His work through our Spiritual Gifts, Heart (or Passion), Abilities, Personality, and Experiences.*

This series is great if you are new to Mt Pleasant or if you have been coming for decades. Each is a stand-alone course. Feel free to jump in for just one or two - or for all three. If you have taken one or two of the courses previously, you are welcome to join us for the other(s).

- **Hebrews: The Nearness of King Jesus by Lisa Harper - led by Megan Williams & Eileen Sloan**

The Book of Hebrews is a rich, dense section of Scripture that can intimidate the most scholarly biblical student. But Lisa Harper makes digging into Hebrews fun and doable, as only she can, without losing an ounce of depth. Hebrews was a sermon for a specific people and culture in the midst of martyrdom and persecution, but is also so relevant for us today, reminding us to continue walking toward Jesus regardless of our culture or our circumstances. Join Lisa as she journeys through this bridge between the Old and New Testaments to get to the heart of the matter.
