# ALTHOUGH WE FIGHT SMALL BATTLES... THE WAR IS ALREADY WON

EPHESIANS 6:12 - FOR WE DO NOT WRESTLE AGAINST FLESH AND BLOOD, BUT AGAINST THE RULERS, AGAINST THE AUTHORITIES, AGAINST THE COSMIC POWERS OVER THIS PRESENT DARKNESS, AGAINST THE SPIRITUAL FORCES OF EVIL IN THE HEAVENLY PLACES.

World War II was the biggest and bloodiest war in the history of the planet. More than thirty nations were involved in the battle for six years starting with the Nazi invasion of Poland in 1939 under the leadership of Adolf Hitler. Historians estimate that between 40 and 50 million people died as a result.

At the war's conclusion, despite Hitler's suicide and the signed surrender of Germany, individual skirmishes continued. As is often the case in war, some German soldiers kept fighting long after their nation was defeated, and the victorious nations had cleaned up their victory parades. Some refused to accept the reality that their kingdom had fallen. Others did not care that they were defeated and simply wanted to inflict as much pain and death as they possibly could.

The war between God and Satan is much like World War II. At the cross of Jesus Christ, Satan was defeated. But skirmishes rage on until our King returns to once and for all round up the rebellious people and spirits and sentence them to an eternal prison as His kingdom overtakes every nation of the earth. These conflicts in your life are not the war-King Jesus already won that! Your battles are fought in the context of a war that is over with a foe who is defeated and will ultimately be disarmed and destroyed.

Find hope, boldness and confidence as you live your life in the strength and victory that Christ provides. He has defeated Satan , sin and death. Because His spirit lives in us... so have we.

## **Mission Committee Missionary Update**

We have received updates from three missionaries that we support.

Mallorie Dennis is in Nicaragua with her husband and two year old daughter. Here is a blurb from her recent newsletter:

Our ministry focuses mostly on sustainable farming here in Nicaragua. Food insecurity is extremely high, as we are ranked one of the poorest countries in Central America. When I was in highschool, I worked at Cooperative Community Ministries in

Thomasville. One volunteer Pastor once said that it is hard to feed the body spiritually, when the body is physically hungry. We know that we can't stop hunger completely here in Nicaragua, however we want to share the gospel with as many individuals as we can. We have started many small farming projects with members in our communities. These include projects with chickens, goats, and our most recent turkeys. We are helping families reproduce their own food, while sharing the gospel.

We want to continue with our monthly projects with our animals, as well as continue with our women's outreach, children's feeding center and our bible distribution. If led to partner with our ministry, here are several ways you can do so listed below.



Adults Bibles: \$5 each Children's Bibles: \$8 each Chicken Program: \$50 per month for one family Feeding Center Program: \$50 per month General Donation to Farm Project: (Funds lacking \$17,000)

Neil Broere from Iron Kite International Ministry sent the following:

As you may know, the Lord brought us from Iraq to the Central Coast of California in April, 2022. We served in Iraq almost 6 years and were completely surprised that God would bring us out of that mission field and into the mission field of California. We moved to Santa Maria, California by faith with no connections and no ministry opportunities...just a word from the Lord burning in our spirits. We took what we learned in Iraq and began walking it out here; prayer, fasting, building relationships, sharing the love of Jesus with those around us. In June of 2022, we were asked to lead a small congregation that was about to close its doors, called Pearl Chapel. After praying and fasting about it, the Lord confirmed it was the next step. We spent our first year here in California building up a church family at Pearl Chapel. In August of last year the owners of the building wanted to use the building for a different purpose so we began meeting in homes and renting a space in town. It's an old Methodist chapel, built in 1897, on top of a hill in the center of town. It's been used for years for weddings and parties, but now the prayers of many in town have been answered and it is once again being used for church gatherings.

Our main focus right now is planting this church and building a healthy church family. We gather in homes on Thursday night for house church and on Sunday nights for our corporate gatherings. We begin our Sunday night gatherings with a potluck meal around a large table, sharing the Lord's Supper together and communion. Rather than moving from the table to chairs in rows, we remain at the table the whole night. It fosters a beautiful interaction between everyone present...similar to Jesus' interaction with His disciples at the Last Supper...gathered around the first communion table. In fact, the name of our church is THE TABLE.

We have seen the lost saved, we have baptized over 20 people (in the ocean :-), and we are seeing steady growth every time we gather. Currently, we have between 50 and 70 on Sunday nights.

Thank you for your prayers and continued support! We think of Mt. Pleasant often and are so grateful for you all. I would love to see you in the future and even have the opportunity to share with the congregation anytime.





We continue to support Abraham Thomas in India. January's newsletter highlighted the ways he continues to serve the Lord through Agape Royal Ministries. We are excited to announce that he is visiting MTP during the services on April 7. Here is some information about one of the children in his ministry. **Suraj** is 14 years old. He was born and raised in a Christian family. He has three older sisters and a younger brother. His father passed away when he was a baby, and his mother has been taking care of the children. He joined our home in 2018 when she was no longer able to do so. Suraj is in 9th grade, and is a very hard working, obedient, and excellent student. He accepted Christ as his Savior and now leads the evening devotions and shares the Word of God with other kids. He is a good singer and plays musical instruments. He is interested in memorizing scripture and spends time in private prayer. He is a multi-talented young man. Please continue to pray for his studies and spiritual life.

The Mission Committee has committed to feed homeless folks at the Cooperative Community Ministry (CCM) once a month, March - November on the 2nd Thursday of each month.

Currently, they are feeding 80 people beginning at 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Meals are handed out at the back door.

There is a small kitchen with a refrigerator, 2 stoves, a microwave and a couple of warmers that do work. Paper products (trays, bags) and packets of mayo, mustard, ketchup are available.

Suggestions for meals are manwiches, grilled chicken sandwiches, hot dogs, and pizza. These are only suggestions, but they like simple food items. Along with any of these, you could provide Little Debbies, fruit, cookies, etc.

More directions will be provided to those who volunteer to help us meet our commitment.


