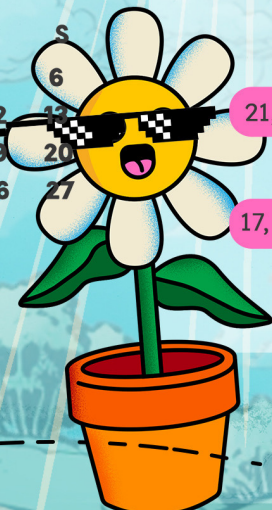

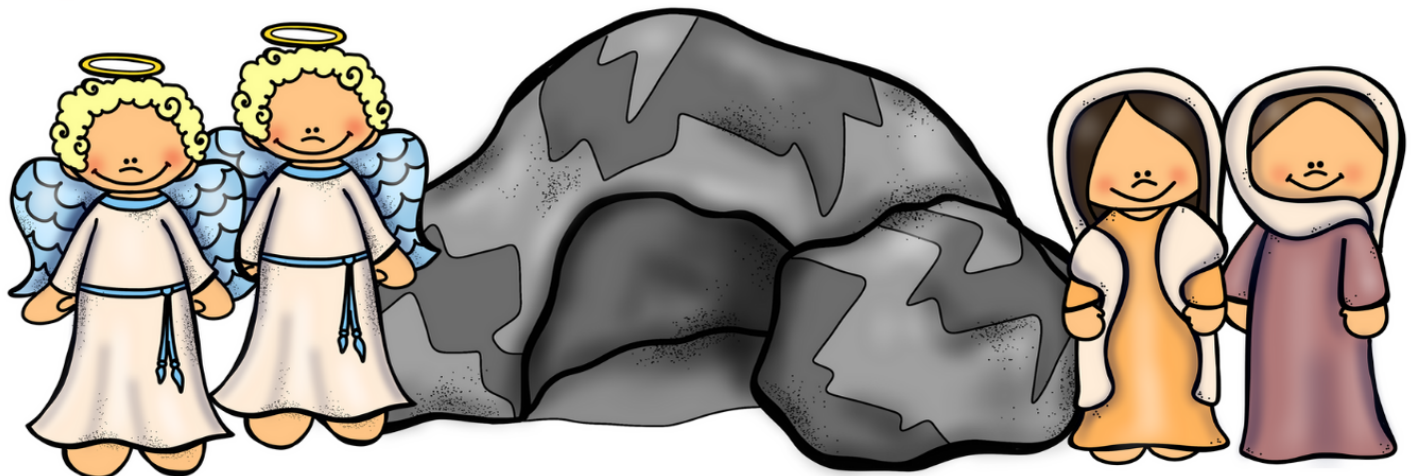

MTP Men's Group

The Men's Group has its sights set on Saturday, March 16, and the annual Wildlife Banquet & Donald Hilton Memorial Auction.

The event is held in the church's Family Life Center. Tickets cover admission, the meal and entry for door prizes, which include adult and youth guns.

The event, the Men's Group's top fund-raiser, begins at 5 p.m. with a pork BBQ meal with traditional sides — baked beans, potato salad, BBQ slaw and coleslaw, dessert, and drinks. People also can sample wildlife dishes. Church member Tom Sharpe is smoking the pork.

Kevin Morris, a pastor in the Charlotte area and an avid hunter, is the guest speaker.

The auction will include firearms, knives, hunting accessories, automotive goods, cakes, sweets and a variety of donated items.

Once held separately, the wildlife banquet and Men's annual auction became a joint event a few years ago with the latter fund-raiser renamed to honor the late Donald Hilton, a longtime Mt. Pleasant member who passed into the Land of Glory in 2013. Mr. Hilton, who was quite active in the Men's Group, was a master woodworker and always made many items for the annual auction.

Tickets can be purchased from a member of the Men's Group or at MtPleasant.Church/events. They also are on sale in the church lobby before services on Sundays.

Tickets cost \$15; \$10 for those 17 and younger. A family pack for parents and children is \$45. You must be present to win a door prize.

The Men's Group will use the money raised to share the unfailing love of Jesus community wide through donations to youth sports organizations, by helping people in need and giving to the church.

She survived by the grace of God, her strong will to live and the help of a man who opened the door of his home to a bleeding young woman, when she pounded on the door begging for help, following her escape from the man she had fought so hard to get away from. She wrote a book to tell her story, *From Victim to Victory*. Joan gave away five copies of the book, and had others to sell. Regina has an amazing story to tell, of how God's Grace has helped her to get past the horrible event in 1985.

Jescena didn't know about the book when she planned the craft for the evening, but we made a bookmark as a craft project.

The next meeting will be March 25th at 6:30 pm, beginning with a meal. We will bring items for a Blessing Box and our Mission Project will be staple food items for The Cooperative Community Ministry (CCM) in Thomasville.

The Missions committee is excited to announce that Abraham Thomas, a missionary in India we have been supporting for 15+ years, is coming to MTP April 6 and 7. We are having a reception for him in the banquet room April 6 at 7 pm. Please come to welcome and support him and hear more about his ministry. April 7th he will be speaking at all three services. Here is a recent message from him with updates on how we can pray for him:

Please do pray as Sunny (Coordinator) and I plan to go to Kenya early next month (February) to teach in Logos Extension school. This is a program we designed to provide theological education to African pastors. This course is for two years. Logos College teachers will travel to Kenya five times in two years to teach. At the time of the course, they would receive a certificate so that they can obtain license. We thank the Lord for this opportunity.

In March, Sunny and I plan to go to Sri Lanka to visit our mission field. This trip is for two weeks. We have started eight churches in Sri Lanka. Praise God.

In April, Elsie and I plan to be in the US for five weeks to visit supporting churches and meet friends.

Our ministry in India, Nepal, Myanmar and Sri Lanka is going very well. The Lord has been so kind to us. We couldn't do it without your prayers and support. We appreciate your partnership.

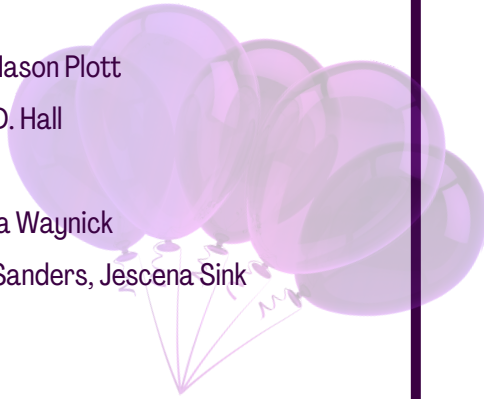
Pickleball Tournament at MTP April 12th and 13th
